The Scientific Conference will be held in the following sections:

1. "Labour in the Digital Economy"

Digital technologies and solutions actively influence labour and labour relations. Opportunities for individual choice of employment formats (including remote, platform work) are growing, and the geographic scope of employee and job search is expanding. At the same time the risks of stability of incomes from employment are increasing and the gaps in social protection and legal regulation of the labour sphere are revealed. The panel will attempt to construct a scientific picture of current changes and trends in labour at the individual, firm, market, and national levels in the digitalized economy.

2. "Problems of Young People's Entry into the Labour Market and Experience in Solving Them"

The section will discuss the main problems facing young people as they enter the labour market. How is labour market structure changing, and how should states, companies, and young people themselves respond to these changes? What are the scale and forms of the discrimination against young people in terms of access to jobs, and what measures are taken against it in Russia and other countries? What are the most effective strategies of graduates and future graduates in the labour market, and how to build the right expectations for the first job? Participants will have an opportunity to present their research on these and other related issues and discuss them with the concerned colleagues.

3. "Social Partnership in the Sphere of Labour in the Context of Digitalization"

Digitalization questions the existing forms of social and labour relations, including social partnership. Is it appropriate to consider social partnership as a factor, mitigating the negative effects of the "digital transformation", which bears a lower degree of social protection in the face of the spread of new employment formats, including distance employment, and the need to restructure organizational processes within enterprises? By what methods and through what mechanisms can it be built? To what extent will trade unions, weakened by the long-term reduction in the inflow of new members, be able to demonstrate bargaining power in determining the parameters of labour relations in the era of digitalization, considering the specific social psychology of workers employed in the most affected industries?

Application for those willing to participate as a speaker should be submitted to the email **conference.piylf@spbu.ru until the 31th of March 2021 (inclusive)**. Registration for the listeners will be additionally announced.

Application should necessarily contain:

- Title of the chosen section;
- Text of the report materials of the volume not less than **20,000 characters with spaces**.

Please note that your article must conform to the formatting rules and reference styles presented in Appendix 1.

Students, undergraduates, graduate students and young scientists up to 30 years old without a scientific degree are invited to participate as speakers. Participation in the work of **only one** section with a report is allowed. After consideration of your theses by the section moderator and in case of its acceptance, you will be invited to present your report at the Scientific Conference not later than on **14th of April**. An official invitation for the educational establishment will be available upon request. If your application is rejected, you will be able to participate as a listener.

It is planned to publish the selected materials of the forum as a **collection of scientific articles** indexed by RSCI. A prerequisite for the publication of the article is the speaker's presentation at the Conference.

Organizational fee is not charged. The format of the Conference will be announced additionally, basing on the epidemiological situation.

At the moment, the conference is considered to be held **remotely**.

General requirements for the design of copyright materials to the collection of student research papers of the Youth Labour forum 2020

A scientific article should necessarily include:

- title;
- abstract (in Russian and English);
- keywords (in Russian and English);
- text;
- list of literature;
- information about author(s):
 - o educational program, specialization;
 - o year of study;
 - o scientific advisor;
 - o e-mail;
 - o phone number.

The article should have the volume of **not less than 20,000 characters with spaces**.

Page size - A4, book orientation, fields 2,5 cm all sides. Times New Roman, color black, font size - 14; 1,5 intervals, indentation of the first line - 1,25; references in square brackets.

In the process of writing the article it is necessary to adhere to the following structure of presentation: *Title, Abstract, Keywords, Main text of the article, Literature*.

Title of the article, indication of the author's name (in full) and the name of the educational institution where the work was carried out, specialization of the author.

Key words (3-5 words), in Russian and English.

The *main text* of the article is divided into an *introduction*, a *description of the methodology*, *results of the study*, and *key findings and implications*. It is desirable to keep the logic of the statement in the article close to the specified structure.

Introduction. The importance of the scientific facts under study in theory and practice. Identification of the research problem and its relevance.

Data on the research methodology. Own scientific research, previous research (on the subject of the article), statistics, methods, etc. - used in this article.

Research results. Analysis, synthesis and explanation of own data or comparison of theories. In terms of volume, it occupies a central place in the article.

Key findings and implications. The article should necessarily contain answers to the questions posed in the introduction and demonstrate specific conclusions.

Literature. The list of literature is drawn up in accordance with GOST 7.12003 or GOST R 7.0.52008 (SNOSKA.INFO is an online resource, which can be used to quickly format the main types of sources according to GOST).

In the text references are numerated in square brackets, the number indicates the source in the list of reference. In the article it is recommended to use no more than 10 literary sources.

Theoretical scientific articles contain the results of research carried out with the help of such methods of cognition as abstraction, synthesis, analysis, induction, deduction, formalization, idealization and modeling. Logical laws and regulations are of paramount importance.

Scientific articles of an empirical nature use a number of theoretical methods, but are more based on methods of measurement, observation, experiment, etc.

Examples of reference to sources:

References in the text of the article to the works from the list of article bibliography (Literature) are in square brackets. The numbering is cross-cutting throughout the text. The first reference in the text corresponds to the first source in the list of the article bibliography. In the text: [10]

If a reference is made to a specific part of the text of a document, the quotation, the reference is indicated by the serial number and the pages on which the reference object is placed. Information is separated by a comma: in the text [10, p. 81]

The objects of the bibliographic reference are also electronic resources of local and remote access. References are both to electronic resources in general (electronic documents, databases, portals, sites, web pages, forums, etc.) and to components of electronic resources (sections and parts of electronic documents, portals, sites, web pages, publications in electronic serial editions, posts on forums, etc.). After the e-mail address, information about the date of access to the electronic network resource is given in parentheses: after the words "date of access", the date, month and year are indicated:
